CIRCULAR

Sub:- Pay Revision 2014 – Crediting of salary arrears to Government Account – New head of account opened – Instructions Issued – reg.

Ref:- 1. G.O.(P) 7/2016/Fin dated 20/01/2016.
2. Circular No. 46/16/Fin dated 19.05.2016
3. GO(Rt) 5498/2016/Fin dated 23.06.2016

As per the circular read as second paper above, it was instructed, among other things, that in the case of employees who are on deputation to foreign service/Government of India for any period between 01.07.2014 to 31.01.2016 their arrears of pay revision 2014 should be credited to the Government account. But no head of account was specified in the circular.

Government have now opened a new head of account for crediting the arrears to Government account vide GO read as 3rd paper above. In the circumstances, it is directed that all foreign employers/Government of India should credit the arrears to the head of account '0070-60-800-24- Receipt on Account of Pay Revision Arrear to Government Employees on Deputation'.
