ORDER

As per the Government Orders read as first and second papers above sanction was accorded for the implementation of Service & Payroll Administrative Repository for Kerala (SPARK) for all Government employees. As per the Government order read as third paper above each Government office were categorized into four categories for the time bound implementation of SPARK. But it has come to the notice of Government that the progress of implementation of SPARK in many departments is not satisfactory.

In the monthly conference of the Chief Secretary with the Secretaries held on 6.6.2009, Chief Secretary has suggested that Secretary(IT) may hold a meeting with the Secretaries and Heads of Departments who have not achieved the target to implement SPARK as per timelines decided vide reference third above, to discuss the impediments and finalise revised timelines. Accordingly Secretary (IT) convened a meeting with the Secretaries and Heads of the concerned Departments on 10.07.2009 and after detailed discussion with each Department, revised time frame was fixed for the implementation of SPARK.

Government have considered the views of Departments and order the following three revised deadlines for implementation of SPARK.

Government also order that Heads of Departments would be responsible for complying with these revised deadlines.

1. List A - Salary to be processed from September 2009.
2. List B - Salary to be processed from November 2009.
3. List C - Salary to be processed from January 2010.
